

Micro-organism!



What do you understand by the term 'micro- organism'?

When we say micro-organism, some people think they are harmful, but actually, they are not only harmful but are also useful in many ways. They are small creatures that you can't see with your naked eye. When someone coughs, sneezes or yawns around you, thousands of bacteria go into your mouth. However, your immune system fights against them so they aren't able to harm you.

How are micro-organisms useful to us???

They are useful in many ways. Some of them decompose waste products like sewage and dead plants or animals. Some of them are used in dairy products such as milk and yogurt. Did you know that some of them absorb fatty acids which cells need to grow? In my opinion, I think that they are a magical part of our daily life. On the other hand, harmful bacteria can cause illnesses, such as food poisoning. Food poisoning is caused by food which is contaminated with bacteria, viruses, chemicals or poisonous metals like lead. Harmful micro-organisms can also cause

tuberculosis, AIDS, or even Measles.

When you have a vaccination, the doctor puts a small amount of bacteria into you, so that your body's immune system will attack back and remember that bacteria.

In some countries like Canada or Norway, they use bacteria to remove the sewage when the toilet is blocked. They put some bacteria into the toilet tank and the bacteria then eats all the sewage. And the amazing point is that after the bacteria have eaten all the poop in the tank, the left over water is good enough to safely drink! Imagine that! Also, bacteria can be used to remove oil spills from a ship!

- Wash your hands often using soap.

How to wash your hands properly




Follow these steps to wash your hands

- 1. Wet your hands with running water.
- 2. Apply soap to your hands.

What is geometry?





A square array of numbers are arranged in horizontals, verticals and diagonals in such a way that all numbers are


$$1, 2, 3, \ldots, n^2$$
